## XVI. Course Details

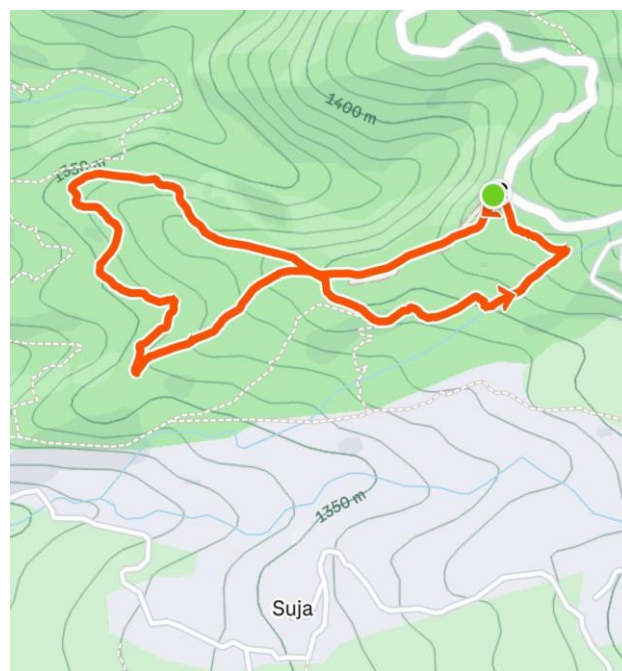
**Cross Country Venue** : The Bir course leverages the varied terrain of the Dhauladhar range, offering a challenging mix of uphill climbs, technical descents, and scenic cross-country sections. The course has been divided into three main loops to cater to different race formats (Cross-Country Olympic - XCO, Cross-Country Short Track - XCC, Cross-Country Eliminator - XCE)

### a. CROSS – COUNTRY OLYMPIC (XCO) Course

The XCO course is a 3.5 km loop with an elevation gain of roughly 100 meters per lap. The course features rocky sections, forest single-track, and a challenging climb up to the Billing ridge access road.

The Cross country course is located about a kilometer away from the event venue or the landing site. (This venue includes all 3 format course - XCC, XCE, XCO: Distance varying from 1km to 3.5k long). The Downhill Start point is located around 14km above at the Billing Paragliding Launch Pad area. (The Course is split in 2 segments with a distance spanning 2 km combined).

b. **CROSS - COUNTRY ELIMINATOR (XCE) Course**

XCE Course is 800 m long, and the part of the SCO course where the starting and finishing at same point.

c. **Cross-Country Short Track (XCC) Course**

XCC Course is 800 m long, and the part of the SCO course where the starting and finishing at same point.

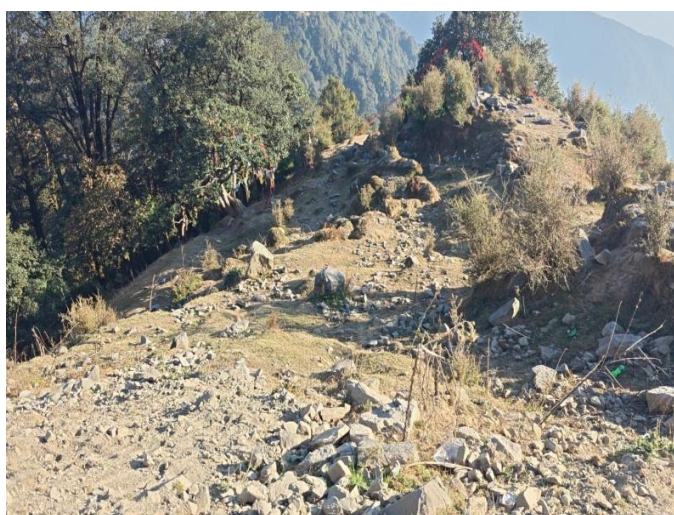
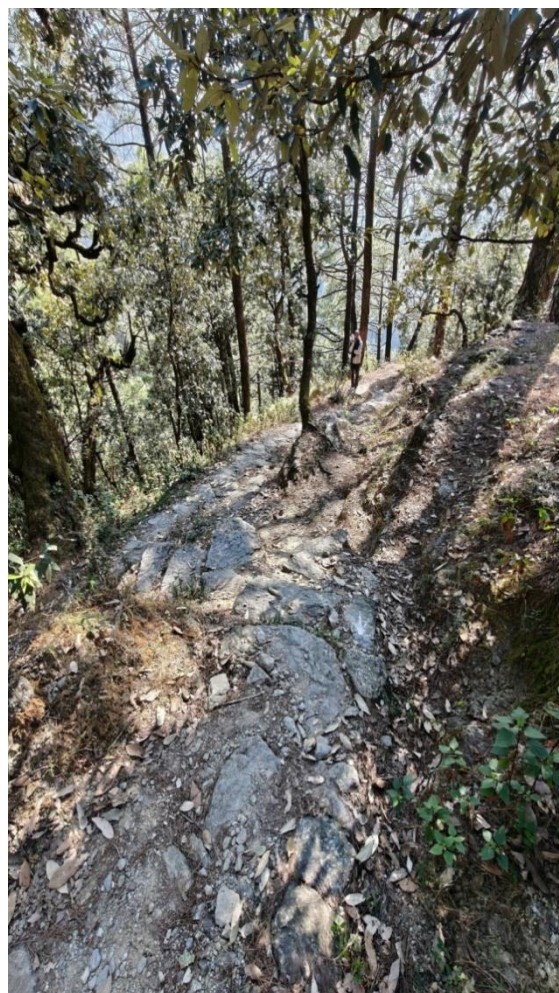
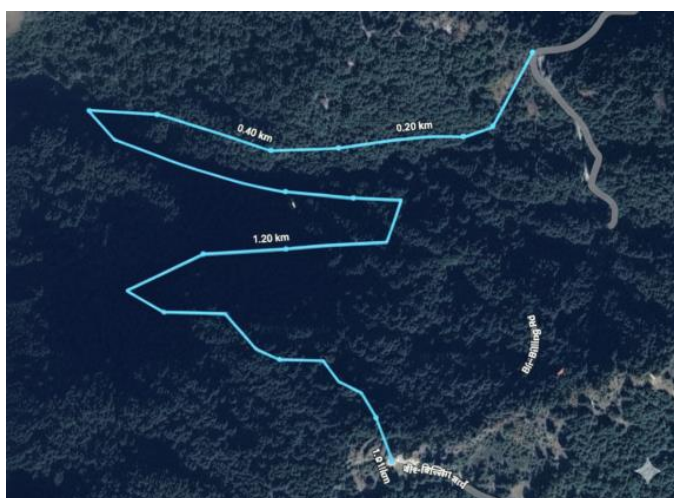


d. **DOWNHILL COURSE (DHI) -1.5 KM.**

**Downhill :** The Billing Paragliding Launch Pad, situated high in the mountains is where the DHI start gate is situated, offering a stunning ramp for take-off against the backdrop of the massive Dhauladhar range and the distant, ice-peaked Himalayas. The launch is a spectacular event, as the paragliders launch from the grassy terrain, their brightly colored canopies catching the thermals and soaring gracefully into the vast, blue sky over the valley. The course is split into 2 segments where the top portion offers the rock garden section flowing through the goat trail with some punchy corners and zipping through the tight path, it leads to the grass lands offering in some sliding switchbacks followed by the 2nd half of the course. The next segment offers the fast flowy descent with some technical tight corners in the wooden stretch and at last drops to a tarmac finish.

**Downhill (DHI) Course**

The DHI course starts near the upper Billing area and descends rapidly towards the Bir landing site. It features major technical obstacles, including drops, jumps, and steep gradients.
